- Have had radiotherapy to your jaw area.
- Have uncontrolled diabetes.
- Suffer from uncontrolled or active gum disease and receding gums.

If you have any medical problems, do have a chat with us and we can let you know if dental implants will be suitable for you.

Q. How long do implants last?

Many people choose dental implants over dentures as they are a more permanent option. Dentures only tend to last for 5 -10 years. Dental implants are a long-term solution that means you don't really need to think about your teeth. We have patients who have had their implants for over 20 years and as long as they are looked after, they should last a lifetime.

Latest evidence suggests that 95% of dental implants will last for 15 years or more.

Provided they are carefully cleaned and looked after, dental implants will usually last longer than crowns, bridges or dentures. If you maintain them well and your mouth stays healthy, then they will last years and probably for your lifetime.

Preserve healthy bone

When your natural tooth is removed, the bone within the jaw that supported it dissolves away. Placing a dental implant to replace the tooth helps to conserve that bone and avoids the appearance of a shrunken jaw.

No more taking your teeth out at night


Because dental implants provide a fixed tooth replacement, there is no need to remove them at night time.
